I. Persecution

- A. Stephen's stoning proceeded the persecution
- B. "They" were scattered
- C. Saul was "ravaging" the church
- D. Persecution reveals faithfulness (Persecution strengthened the faith of believers)

II. Faithfulness

- A. The "scattered" shared the word of God
- B. Philip went to the city of Samaria
- C. Many paid attention because of the signs and wonders
- D. Faithfulness of believers brings spiritual growth

III. Spiritual Growth

- A. People listened, believed, and were baptized
- B. Simon
 - 1. Practiced magic
 - 2. All paid attention to him
 - 3. "power of God that is called Great"
 - 4. Believed, baptized, and continued with Philip
- C. Spiritual growth reveals truth in our lives.

IV. Truth is revealed

- A. Peter and John visit the city
 - 1. Apostles at Jerusalem heard about the "revival"
 - 2. Sent Peter and John
- B. Holy Spirit is received
 - 1. Laid hands on and people received Him
 - 2. Why not at salvation?
 - 3. Gives unity to faith in Christ for all Believers
- C. Simon wants the "gift"

- 1. Previously the one everyone paid attention to
- 2. Wanted the gift, even if it costs money
- 3. Peter identifies Simon's heart problem
- 4. Told to repent
- D. Repentance brings change to the heart
 - 1. Repent, remorse
 - 2. Turning about
 - 3. Beginning a new relationship with God (positive side)
 - 4. Hebrews 6:1
 - 5. *Repentance is a changed heart
- E. Life will reveal a heart

- C. Opportunities: Do you take opportunities of service when they are available?
- D. Fruit: What fruit of Christ does your life reveal?
