## Acts 1:12-26 Called

\*Every person has (is called to) a position of service in God's kingdom. Prayer helps to discover that calling.

#### I. <u>Prayer</u> (1:12-14)

- A. Return to Jerusalem from Mount of Olives
  - 1. Mount of Olives just east of Jerusalem (pictures)
  - 2. Sabbath Day's walk was about 3,000 steps (as allowed)
  - 3. Pictures from Israel trip to Mount of Olives
- B. 11 apostles gathered with others
  - 1. Judas Iscariot already gone (dead)
  - 2. Mary and other women present
  - 3. Jesus' brothers (James and Jude included)
  - 4. 120 listed as total number present
- C. In one "accord"
  - 1. "Accord" = one "mind"
- 2. Unified in the resurrection and encouraged by the return of Christ
- D. Praying for what's next (God's will to be done)
  - 1. God's will to be done
  - 2. No Holy Spirit yet so what guided them?
  - 3. Relationship with Christ (knowing Him personally)
  - 4. Scripture (only OT at this time; Psalms)
  - 5. Prayer is intended to focus us on God's will and the Holy Spirit's leading
    - => "Before it is to called a house of Bible teaching a house of evangelism, a house of discipleship, or a house of prayer." (0.S. Hawkins, *The Believer's Code*, August 10, page 241)
    - The disciples never asked Jesus to teach them to preach, evangelize, teach, or grow churches. We only have recorded that they asked Jesus to teach them to pray (Hawkins).

### II. Position (1:15-20)

- A. Peter takes the lead
- B. Side note on Judas' death
- C. Uses Scripture for basis of next move
  - 1. Psalms 69:25; 109:8
  - 2. Gave credit to Holy Spirit for the prophecy
- D. Fill the "office" or position of "apostle"

- 1. Office = overseer; definite function or a fixed office
- 2. Matthew 19:28; Luke 22:28-30

### III. <u>Person</u> (1:21-26)

- A. Qualifications for an apostle
  - 1. Been with them since John baptized Jesus
  - 2. Stayed with them during the days of jesus' earthly ministry
  - 3. Saw the resurrected Jesus
- B. The work would be as "a witness to His resurrection"
  - 1. Saw the resurrected jesus
  - 2. Knew His commands to obey (Matt. 28:19-20)
- C. Choice narrowed to two men: Joseph (!) and Matthias
  - 1. Joseph given three names
    - Barsabbas: "son of God's will"" "son of Sabbath"
    - Justus: Roman name; just; high integrity
  - 2. Matthais
    - Eusebius says one of the Seventy (Luke 10: 1-20)
    - Relatively unknown
- D. Casts lots to discover God's choice: Matthais
  - 1. God's choice (Proverbs 16:33)
  - 2. Against man's choice?
  - 3. God always chooses by the heart more than anything else
  - 4. =>Moses, Ephraim and Manassa, David over his brothers

- B. Identify your calling in the work of the Kingdom by naming your position.
- C. In what area is God calling you to work but you are hesitating because you do not fill adequate or qualified?
