Acts 3:11-26 Walking in Christ, Part 2: The Witness of Christ [Be a Witness]

*A believer's walk will be a witness for Christ. Then a believer will either proclaim Christ or deny Him

I. We are called to be witness

- A. You will be my WITNESS (Acts 1:8)
- B. One of these men must become a WITNESS with us (Acts 1:22)
- C. This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are WITNESSES (Acts 2:33)
- D. Order: God moves>lives are impacted>God is proclaimed>people saved

II. Tell Who God is

- A. God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; our fathers
- B. Author of life
- C. Holy and Righteous One
- D. Received in Heaven

III. Tell Who Man is

- A. Delivered over and denied Christ (for a murderer)
- B. Killed the Author of life
- C. Acted in ignorance

IV. Tell What God did

- A. God raised Him from the dead
- B. Made this man strong (in perfect health)
- C. Foretold by the mouths of prophets (Moses, Samuel, those who came after him)
- D. Sent Christ
 - i Raised up His servant
 - ii Sent Him to you (Jews)
 - iii Blessed you (turned you from wickedness)

V. Tell What Man must do (Live it Out)

- A. Have faith in His name
- B. Repent
- C. Follow ("listen to Him in whatever He tells you")

VI. A believer's walk will be a witness for Christ
