Acts 4:23-5:11 True Faith vs False Faith

=>Hypocrite: The worst thing anyone can be. It's also the Greek word for actor.

*True faith will bring out the best in us. False faith will bring out the worst in us.

I. The Best

- A. Believers living in faith
 - 1. One heart and soul (mind)
 - 2. Apostles testified with power and grace
- B. Good example
 - 1. Joseph of Cyprus
 - 2. Barnabas = son of encouragement
 - 3. An example becomes a pattern for others to follow
- C. Result: Faith leads believers to use life to help others. Meeting physical and spiritual needs.

II. The Worst

- A. "Believers" not living by faith
 - 1. Ananias and Sapphira
 - 2. Made a commitment to God
 - 3. Posing for posture = hypocrite
- B. Satin filled their hearts
 - 1. It was their property to use or not
 - 2. Focus was on man and not God (how they look before man instead of how they stand before God)
- C. Result: Claiming a faith and not living in faith is lying to God.

III. Great Fear

A. Seized the whole "church"

- B. "All who heard"
- C. Fear of God
 - 1. Concerned with God's reaction
 - 2. Zephaniah 1:5-6
 - 3. "Penalty" or "Rule" miracle
- D. Result: God's love casts out fear. (1 John 4:18)
