- D. Not searching for truth but for personal justification

- D. Tent of witness
- E. Stephen: "You are now rejecting the Christ
 - 1. They were looking for a person, place, and thing for God's salvation. (Messiah, Jerusalem/Israel, temple)
 - 2. Rejecting Christ is rejecting God's plan for salvation
 - 3. What is God's plan for salvation: Acts 4:12. Only in the person of Christ

- A. Consequences of rejecting salvation: separation from God (eternally)
- B. Causes people to go against the things of God
- C. They want to remove Christ but separate from God instead.
- D. Gamaliel warned about this earlier
