Acts 1:1-11 The Birth of the Church

- I. Acts
 - A. Written by Luke
 - 1. 67 A.D
 - 2. Same as the Gospel of Luke (1:3)
 - a) Theophilus (lover of God)
 - b) A sequel to Luke
 - 3. Followed Paul and recorded the events (2 Timothy 4:11)
 - B. Called "Acts of the Apostles"
 - C. Outline of the book (1:8)
 - D. The Church is birthed
 - 1. Stories of the Apostles and disciples
 - 2. Church is always in the background of the work

*The birth of the church was an on-going call for believers to be faithful to Christ's mission

II. The Presence of the Holy Spirit (1-5)

- A. Christ is risen and appearing to many (and apostles)
- B. Reminded to wait for "the promise"
- C. Baptism
 - 1. John the Baptist: repentance and ritual
 - 2. Holy Spirit: Complete immersion and surrender
- D. Be overcome by the presence of God

III. The Power of the Holy Spirit (6-8)

- A. Apostles met with Jesus
 - 1. Only 11 now
 - 2. Met in Jerusalem (1:4)
- B. They wanted to reestablish the Kingdom of Israel
 - 1. Always thought Messiah was to establish kingdom on earth
 - 2. Luke 17:21
 - 3. Kingdom of God is first set up in our hearts
- C. Called to be a witness
 - 1. Expert vs Eyewitness

- 2. Teach all that I commanded (Matt. 28:19-20)
- 3. Witness to everyone everywhere
- 4. "Witness" = "martyr"
- D. The presence of God inside comes to the outside
 - 1. What we are filled with eventually comes out
 - 2. Who we are on the inside is reflected to the outside

IV. The patience of the Holy Spirit (9-11)

- A. Jesus ascends into heaven
 - 1. Taken up by a cloud
 - 2. Returned to heaven but did not die again (post resurrection)
- B. Two men appear
 - 1. Angels
 - 2. White robes symbolizes spiritual purity
 - 3. Messengers
- C. Jesus will come back
 - 1. The promise of a return for hope
 - 2. The challenge to be faithfully at work for the mission
- D. Be a worker on mission for Christ (Luke 19:10)

V. Live It Out

- A. Acknowledge the presence of God and the Holy Spirit
- B. Acknowledge the commands and commission believers have been given
- C. Recognize how you are "waiting" on Christ's return
